Compliance Statement

RoHS

International Hardcoat (IHC, Inc.) certifies compliance with the provisions of the European Parliament and Council Directive on the Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment (2002/95/EC) and regulations promulgated there under, collectively, the “RoHS Regulations.”

Based on information obtained from our suppliers IHC, INC. products do not contain prohibited materials

REACH

IHC, Inc., also certifies that all IHC, Inc., processes comply with the REACH Directive. IHC processes are free of substances of concern up to 0.1% by weight as established by the list of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) as listed by the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) under the provisions of Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the council concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization, and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) per the ECHA 20/12/2010 and previous updates.

There has been an addition of **SVHC substances** to the candidate list on **16th June 2014**. These substances are not contained in any IHC Process.

The provisions of IHC, Inc.s certificate supersede and replace the provisions of all other certificates previously delivered relating to compliance with the RoHS and REACH Regulations.
